Many Lomography cameras so you can take funky arty photos while visiting Japan.

Gifts that are sure to make your friend who has everything smile... like a toilet-shaped curry bowl (plastic-shaped poop not included) in classic ceramic or gilded gold! —or funky coasters of dogs dressed as your favorite rock star.
